

Declaration on the Intention of Administration with Integrity by the Department of Groundwater Resources

According to Cabinet's consensus on 23rd January 2018, regarding the collaboration from all governmental sectors to take part in the Integrity and Transparency Assessment (ITA) during the fiscal year of 2018 – 2021, chief executives have to express their intensions or pledge to work and administrate in the moral, transparent and accountable manners, following the Office of the National Anti-Corruption Commission's ITA indicator No. O34: Declaration of Integrity Intension.

The Department of Groundwater Resources, therefore, declare the integrity intension for officials to perform as follows:

- 1. Performing duties based on the regulations and principles of integrity, transparency, and morality, not using their status for their own benefits or bribery.
- 2. Upholding justice and being a good role model for society.
- 3. Providing reliable and accessible information for publics and giving stakeholders an opportunity to participate and investigate the Term of Reference process in order to improve it to be more rapid, equal, transparent, and moral.
- 4. Performing duties in responsible manner and accept your actions.
- 5. Utilising resources in a sustainable and effective manner for public benefits.
- 6. Communicating with and educating others to create more collaborative and efficient work environment.
